5th Sunday of Easter May 10, 2020

Do not let your hearts be troubled. (John 14:1)

Not troubled? That's hard to imagine! Jesus had just predicted that Judas would betray him and Peter would deny him. He had just told the disciples that he would be with them "only a little while longer" (John 13:33). Something really big was about to happen. *Of course* the disciples were shaken up! Anyone would be upset and anxious.

Be at peace, Jesus said. Don't be afraid. It's the most common command in the Gospels. Much of the time, Jesus says it when the disciples catch a glimpse of his glory. Think about his Transfiguration, or when he walked on water. But this time, Jesus reassures them because he is leaving. You are used to having me walk with you in one way, he seemed to be saying, but once I'm gone, I'll be with you in a new way. I will never leave you, even if you have a hard time finding me the way you used to.

Jesus wanted his friends to know that even though he would not be with them in bodily form, he wasn't really leaving them alone. He would be with them through the Holy Spirit living inside them. He would be with them in his Eucharistic presence. He would be present in their brothers and sisters in the faith. They just needed to learn to see him in a different way.

Like the disciples, we experience change in our lives—change that might make us wonder if Jesus is still with us. The things we are accustomed to can get disrupted. Our youngest child moves out of the house and goes off to college. The main breadwinner in the family loses their job, and we have to relocate to a new city. But Jesus hasn't left us alone during these times. He wants to give us eyes to see him in every situation.

So take his words to heart: Do not let your hearts be troubled. You have faith in God; have faith also in me (John 14:1).

"Jesus, help me trust that you are with me always. Lord, come and calm all my fears." (Excerpt from The **WORD** Among Us)

Since The Canadian Mental Health Association marks May 4-10 as Mental Health Week, we would like to add to the Archdiocese of Toronto Catholic Family Services that we shared last week, by listing additional services available to our community in Etobicoke Centre offered by the City of Toronto, the Province of Ontario, and The Government of Canada.

Assaulted Women's Helpline: 416-863-0511; free, anonymous and confidential 24-hour telephone and TTY crisis telephone line to all women in the province of Ontario who have experienced any form of abuse.

Distress Centre: 416-408-HELP (4357) Callers can express their thoughts and feelings in confidence. Callers' issues can include problems related to domestic violence, social isolation, suicide, addictions, mental and physical health concerns. This is a 24 hours service.

Gerstein Centre: (416) 929-5200 provides crisis intervention to adults, living in the *City of Toronto*, and now including Etobicoke, who experience mental health problems. The service has three aspects; telephone support, community visits and a ten-bed, short-stay residence. All three aspects of the service are accessed through the crisis line.

Kids Help Phone: 1-800-668-6868 is a free, anonymous and confidential phone and on-line professional counselling service for youth. Big or small concerns. 24/7. 365 days a year.

Toronto Seniors Helpline: 416-217-2077 is a specialized service for seniors in Toronto which provides assistance in stabilizing age-related mental health and addiction crises, risk and safety assessments, immediate referrals to community mobile crisis units, and support for families and caregivers. *This service requires you to leave a message and someone will call you back.*

Emergency Shelter

Central Intake: 416-338-4766; Toll Free 1-877-338-3398 For individuals or for families requiring emergency shelter.

<u>ConnexOntario</u> offers province-wide information and referral services for those experiencing mental health issues, drug or alcohol addiction, or problem gambling.
