12th Sunday Ordinary Time June 21, 2020

My persecutors will stumble, they will not triumph. (Jeremiah 20:11) Jeremiah was not having a good week. He had been arrested, beaten, and thrown into prison. Then, having been released, he pronounces an oracle of destruction against Jerusalem and offers a bitter prayer accusing the Lord of "seducing" him into this dangerous ministry. And he prays for the chance to see his enemies' downfall—and to savor it!

Today's reading is not what Jesus had in mind when he said, "Love your enemies, and pray for those who persecute you". We have only to think of Jesus' words of forgiveness on the cross to see how he really wants his people to respond to persecution and enmity.

It's comforting to know that even a great prophet like Jeremiah had bad days. It gives us some perspective on our own lives. Who among us hasn't wished vengeance on someone who has hurt us? We know we shouldn't, we know it's wrong, but sometimes we find it very hard to resist the pull toward resentment and revenge.

The truth is, change takes time, and we have to keep working at it. We have to keep checking our thoughts, examining our motives, and holding our tongues until we develop the virtues that mirror Jesus' perfect, unconditional love. We also have to keep pressing in to stay close to the Lord so that his love continues to shape our hearts.

But remember this: you are not alone! You are part of a Church filled with saints, both famous and obscure, who show that change is possible. You also have friends you can turn to for support when you need it. And most important—and most reassuring—you have the Holy Spirit, who is always ready to remind you of Jesus' love and to give you his grace and encouragement.

Jeremiah had far more good days than bad days because he never gave up. Neither should we.

"Lord, teach me how to love everyone, even the people who are making my life difficult."

Re-opening of the Church: All Saints' Parish

We are very happy to announce the re-opening of our church, please be aware of the following information.

Before coming:

- At home, take your temperature and monitor for symptoms. Stay home if you are not feeling well or have a compromised immune system.
- If you have been in contact with a COVID-19 positive individual, please self-isolate. Consult your local health professional.
- Wash your hands with soap and water for 20 seconds before leaving for church.
- Bring a mask or face covering with you. (MANDATORY)

If a return to Mass in any form is not prudent for health reasons (medical conditions or if you or any family member in the same household is sick) or for any other concerns, then please stay home.

The day you are coming to Mass or to Pray:

- There will only be one entrance into the church. Please look for signs marking the proper entrance door. (Main entrance at La Rose).
- Please Sanitize your hands when you enter.
- Please leave your offering in baskets at the entrance/exit. There will be no collection during Mass.
- Maintain physical distancing at all times. Stay 2 mts (or 6 feet) away from others.
- <u>The washrooms will be closed</u>, it will be open only for urgent situations. We ahve volunteers to guide you if needed.
- There will be <u>no singing during Mass</u>.
- Please remove your mask only to receive communion and put it back on immediately.
- Communion will be given in the hand.

Sunday June 21 at 11:30 am (English) Starting Monday June 22, the church will be open for prayers from 7:30 am to 9:00 am; and we will celebrate the daily Mass at 8:15 am from Monday to Saturday starting also on June 22. After 9:00 am, the church will be closed to allow the disinfection of the church for the next day.

All Saints Church has Capacity for 150 parishioners and we will work on a first come first

serve basis for now. Please arrive at least <u>15</u> <u>minutes before</u> the Mass starts.

- For confessions please leave a message with your name and phone number to set up an appointment or send us an email.
- For Celebrations such as baptisms and weddings, we will start organizing schedules and appointment with capacity restrictions.
- Regarding funerals, please contact the Funeral Home and Father Andrzej Glaba and they will set up prayers and Mass times with you.
- The office will be open to public only by appointment, please contact us by phone or email and we will get back to you as soon as possible.
- There will be no candles to light.
- We have placed all the <u>Sunday Missals</u> on a table, please feel free to take one and leave a small donation. That will be for your copy for the rest of the year.

Father Glaba will continue to livestream the Sunday Masses. Dispensation from the Sunday and Holy Day obligation has been extended by the Archdiocese.
