15<sup>th</sup> Sunday Ordinary Time July 12, 2020

You shall indeed hear but not understand. (Matthew 13:14)

Any parent can tell you what it's like to be heard but not understood: "In one ear and out the other" or "It's like talking to a brick wall." This is how it feels when they can't seem to connect with their children.

Jesus had a similar experience. Despite all his time teaching and performing miracles in Galilee, he had little to show for it. Of course, disciples like Peter and Mary Magdalene and the others had left everything to follow him. They were trying to listen closely and put his teachings into practice. But what about the "large crowds" that he always attracted (Matthew 13:2)? They had seen the same miracles, but many of them didn't see his compassion as something worth imitating. They had heard him talk about his Father's mercy, but many didn't seem to hear his words about loving their enemies.

Jesus' words make it clear that discipleship involves both receiving his miracles *and* following his teachings. It involves the excitement of experiencing his power and love, *and* it involves choosing to love him back by trying to become more like him. It involves making sure that our hearts are like the good soil in today's parable—listening intently and prayerfully to his words so that they can change our hearts.

Try to do just that today. Either before or after Mass, carve out fifteen minutes and focus on *hearing* Jesus speak to you. Find a quiet spot, choose one of the readings from today's Mass, and read it. Really read it. Ask the Holy Spirit to be with you and help you understand what God is saying. When a word or phrase leaps out at you, let it sink into your heart like seed in good soil. Ask Jesus what he wants you to do about it. Then do it. Let his word bear fruit in your life.

"Thank you, Jesus, for sowing your word into my heart. Help me to nurture it so that I can become more like you." (Excerpt from The **WORD** Among Us)

The office will be open to the public Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 9:00am to 12:00pm or by appointment.

## <u>Re-opening of the Church:</u> <u>All Saints' Parish</u>

We are very happy to announce the re-opening of our church, please be aware of the following information.

Before coming:

- At home, take your temperature and monitor for symptoms. Stay home if you are not feeling well or have a compromised immune system.
- If you have been in contact with a COVID-19 positive individual, please self-isolate. Consult your local health professional.
- Wash your hands with soap and water for 20 seconds before leaving for church.
- Bring a mask or face covering with you. (MANDATORY)

If a return to Mass in any form is not prudent for health reasons (medical conditions or if you or any family member in the same household is sick) or for any other concerns, then please stay home. The day you are coming to Mass or to Pray:

- There will only be one entrance into the church. Please look for signs marking the proper entrance door. (Main entrance at La Rose).
- Please Sanitize your hands when you enter.
- Please leave your offering in the baskets inside the Church. There will be no collection during Mass.
- Maintain physical distancing at all times. Stay 2 mts (or 6 feet) away from others.
- <u>The washrooms will be closed</u>, it will be open only for urgent situations. We have volunteers to guide you if needed.
- There will be <u>no singing during Mass</u>.
- Please remove your mask only to receive communion and put it back on immediately.
- Communion will be given in the hand.

On Monday, Wednesday and Friday, the Church will be open for prayers from 7:30am to 12:00pm. After that, the church will be closed to allow the disinfection for the next day.

All Saints Church has Capacity for 150 parishioners and we will work on a first come first serve basis for now. Please arrive at least <u>15</u> <u>minutes before</u> the Mass starts.

- For confessions please leave a message with your name and phone number to set up an appointment or send us an email.
- For Celebrations such as baptisms and weddings, we will start organizing schedules and appointment with capacity restrictions.
- Regarding funerals, please contact the Funeral Home and Father Andrzej Glaba and they will set up prayers and Mass times with you.
- The office will be open to public only by appointment, please contact us by phone or email and we will get back to you as soon as possible.
- There will be no candles to light.
- We have placed all the <u>Sunday Missals</u> on a table, please feel free to take one and leave a small donation. That will be for your copy for the rest of the year.

Please notice we <u>will not</u> have Eucharistic Adoration during the summer. We will start again in September God's permitting.

Father Glaba will continue to livestream the Sunday Masses at 8:00 am. Dispensation from the Sunday and Holy Day obligation has been extended by the Archdiocese.
