25th Sunday Ordinary Time September 20, 2020

My thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways my ways. (Isaiah 55:8)

There's no doubt about it—there are times when we just can't understand why God doesn't see things our way. Why doesn't he just give us the job we want or the healing we are asking for or the reconciliation we long for? *It would make so much sense, Lord, just to do what I'm asking.*

But we also know that, in this life at least, we won't always understand God's ways. They are as far above us as the heavens are to the earth.

Today's Gospel illustrates this point exactly. Who would pay the same wage to the laborer who arrived early and the one who arrived an hour before quitting time? Only God can be so generous as to want to care equally for all those who come to him, whether they arrive early or come much later.

And that's why we can be thankful that God's ways are so far above our own. Look at how the Lord cared for his chosen people over the centuries. Even though there were many occasions when he could have abandoned them, he never did, no matter how far they had strayed. They only had to seek him to find mercy.

Each week at Mass, we are privileged to witness God's mercy in action, when he transforms ordinary bread and wine into Jesus' Body and Blood. What a God we have, who loves us so much that he gives us not only his mercy but his very self in the Eucharist! This is so much beyond anything we could ever expect or imagine.

Yes, God's ways are above our ways. He gives his love and mercy without measure, without cost, to anyone who comes to him. Early bird or latecomer, sinner or saint—all are welcome. As we are nourished by Jesus in the Eucharist, may our ways grow to become ever more like his.

ONLY FAMILIES THAT PRE-REGISTER WILL BE ENROLLED IN THE SACRAMENTAL PROGRAM.

In order to assist you in your decision to enroll your children or not, please find the perquisites for registering and some changes as to how the programs may be delivered this year due to COVID-19:

PREQUISITES FOR ALL SACRAMENTS:

1. According to the Archdiocesan Law, the Sacraments must take place in the parish where the family attends on a regular Sunday basis, not in the parish of the school where the child attends.

2. You and your family should feel comfortable coming to Sunday Mass. The sacramental preparation program requires your full commitment to attend and participate in the Mass at All Saint's every Sunday and all instruction classes.

Please note that if you are uncomfortable coming to church or with your children participating in the Sacramental Programs, it can be deferred. Receiving the sacraments is not MANDATORY. "A sacrament is a Christian rite recognized as of particular importance and significance" and should be received if one wishes to be a full member of the church.
