29th Sunday Ordinary Time October 18, 2020

Why are you testing me, you hypocrites? (Matthew 22:18)

These Pharisees and Herodians thought they had come up with a foolproof plan to ensnare Jesus. If he said it was lawful to pay the census tax, the people would turn against him since they hated the tax. If he said it was not lawful, he would be in trouble with the Roman authorities. In order to look sincere, they prefaced their question by flattering Jesus. But Jesus saw right through their plan and called them on it.

Clearly, hypocrisy was something that angered Jesus. In a series of "woes," he called the religious leaders who opposed him hypocrites for not following the very precepts they were teaching (Matthew 23:13-29). And in his Sermon on the Mount, he warns people not to pray or fast like "the hypocrites" who do it just to look good in front of others (6:5, 16).

The word "hypocrisy" comes from the Greek word *hypokrisis*, which means acting on a stage. When we are hypocritical, we are putting on an act, saying one thing and then doing the opposite. But when our actions betray our words, we have to ask ourselves if we really believe what we say we do.

We are all susceptible to hypocrisy—it's one of those unfortunate consequences of our fallen human nature. For example, we might lecture our children about not spending too much time on their screens and then spend hours and hours watching TV. Or we may claim that we are a team player at work but then create division by criticizing a fellow coworker.

It can be a painful process to search our consciences and discover ways in which our actions aren't lining up with our beliefs. But the Lord understands our struggles and will forgive us and help us to change. Best of all, the more we are able to authentically live out our Christian beliefs, the more we can become living witnesses to Jesus—and the kingdom he has ushered in.

Dear fellow All Saints' parishioners,

Behold some food for thought to take your mind off explore COVID and to the universe Thanksgiving from the comfort of your home. In 2019, we participated in The Faith and Astronomy Workshop, FAW, hosted by The Vatican Observatory Foundation, VOF. In our application to participate in this retreat, we stated that as the coordinators of our parish Guest Speakers events and as retired educators we were still interested in finding experts to inspire our community to both learn and to keep the faith. We were drawn to the VO's fascinating explorations of our universe and we promised to share our findings with our communities in Toronto. To our pleasant surprise, we received an invitation to participate. We packed our bags and flew to Tucson, Arizona for this fourday workshop with twenty other international guests.

Please note that the Vatican Observatory, VO, (Specola Vaticana) is an astronomical research and educational institution supported by the Holy See. Originally based in the Roman College of Rome, the Observatory is now headquartered in Castel Gandolfo, Italy, and operates the Vatican Advanced Technology Telescope, VATT, at the Mount Graham International Observatory in Arizona, USA. The VOF is the non-profit fundraising arm that supports the scientific and educational including endeavors the maintenance and modernization of the VATT.

We are still in awe of what we heard, saw, and learned during this four-day spiritual and scientific retreat in the desert. As promised, we have been eager to share our findings. At the suggestion of the Archdiocese of Toronto, we are in the process of working with the Newman Centre Catholic Mission at U of T. The director, Fr. Dr. Peter Turrone, has offered to feature the Vatican Observatory in their future newsletters starting in January 2021. He has also formed the Toronto chapter of the Society of Catholic Scientists, SCS. Together with Fr. Peter and members of the SCS, we've had some Zoom meetings to get to know one another and to share vision. Coincidentally, a new professor at St. Mike's U of T, Fr. Adam Hincks, SJ, who will be teaching courses in both Theology and Cosmology, and who used to work with the VO, has offered to write the first article for The Torch, Newman Centre's Catholic Mission Newsletter. To view The Torch or to follow the Toronto Chapter of the Society of Catholic Scientists, go to: www.newmantoronto.com.

The director of the Vatican Observatory, Br. Guy Consolmagno, SJ, expressed his gratitude for this new promotion and exposure via U of T's Newman Centre Catholic Mission. Our hope is that young scientists who take the time to explore this work will be inspired to keep the faith.

Now we invite you, our fellow All Saints' parishioners, to take a look at the richness of the work of the Vatican Observatory and its Foundation.

Explore their site at <u>www.vofoundation.org</u>. The home page alone is a study in theology, science, history, culture, the arts, and philosophy. Definitely listen to the podcast between Br. Guy Consolmagno and Fr. George Coyne, on <u>Asteroids, Stars, and The</u> <u>Love of God</u>. Consider purchasing one or more copies of the Vatican Observatory 2021 Astrophoto Calendar. We've posted samples at All Saints' for you to see.

Make a point of sharing this site and giving a calendar to anyone who has doubts about the link between Faith and Science. St. Pope John Paul II was a firm supporter of the VO. About Science and Religion, he said to the late director of the VO, Fr. George Coyne: "Each discipline should continue to enrich, nourish, and challenge the other to be more fully what it can be and to contribute to our vision of who we are and who we are becoming....Science can purify religion from error and superstition; religion can purify science from idolatry and false absolutes."

We hope you enjoy this divine exploration too, even if, like us, you are not scientists.
