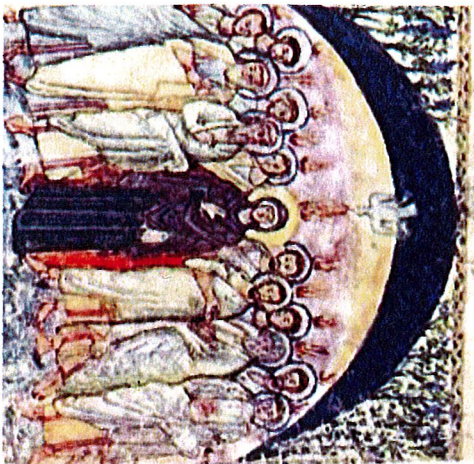

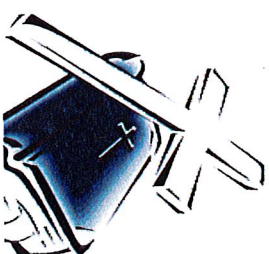
## *Welcome to All Saints' Parish*

## ORGANIZATIONS AT OUR PARISH

**Kid Clubhouse is for children in Grades 2 - 4** This is a new children's youth program that our parish is offering this year. It is for children who want to experience the joy of learning about Jesus. 3rd Friday of every month.

**EDGE—Youth Group for students in Grade 5—7** is a Catholic middle school ministry experience designed to meet the educational, spiritual, emotional and social needs of young adolescents. 2nd, 4th & 5th Friday of every month

**All Saints' Young Adults—Grade 8 up to the age of 35**— involves catechesis & social time. 1st Friday of every month.

**Card Group**— Mondays from 1—3 pm

**Catholic Mom's Group**—meets the 3rd Wednesday of every month

**Children Liturgy**—The gospel is brought to the children at their own level during the 9:30 and 11:30 AM Masses.

**Sacramental Preparation:** Our parish offers programs for during the year for those receiving the sacraments of Baptism, Communion, Confirmation and Marriage.

**Queen of All Saints' Prayer Group**—Wednesday from 7—9 pm

**Italian Prayer Group**—Tuesdays from 7—9 pm

**RCA**—Mondays from 7:30—9 pm

**Senior Exercise Classes**—Every Tuesday—two classes from 9:15—10:15 and 10:30—11:30 am

**Parish Council**—Every first Monday of every month.

**Coffee Sundays**— every first Sunday of the month after the 9:30 and 11:30 AM Masses.

- ◇ **Parish Council** - Their role is to bring forward concerns of the whole parish and advise the pastor.
- ◇ **Knights of Columbus** - Joining the Order of Knights in our Parish
- ◇ **Decorating Ministry** - To keep our Sanctuary beautiful throughout the year with flowers and to decorate the Sanctuary for the our Special Feast Dates and Solemnities (Christmas, Easter, Lent, Advent etc.)
- ◇ **Trustees** - Parishioners count and record the weekly offertory collection and special collections.
- ◇ **Catechist** - These individuals teach and proclaim the Word, giving witness to their faith in dedication to the life of the Church in our Faith Formation programs. Our parish has formation programs for Baptism, Communion and Confirmation and retreats for parents and parishioners.
- ◇ **Bereavement Committee** - These dedicated parishioners provide consolation following a family death.
- ◇ **Social Committee** Helping with social events in the parish—(Coffee Sunday, Feast of All Saints', Immaculate Conception etc.)
- ◇ **Sacristy Committee**—To clean the Sacristy and Altar areas.
- ◇ **Property Committee**—Assisting with building and maintenance of our parish.
- ◇ **St. Vincent to De Paul** - To assist the less fortunate in our Parish.
- ◇ **Welcoming Committee** - Welcome and meet with new parishioners registering in our church.
- ◇ **Volunteer with the Youth Programs Volunteer Positions—(Students can earn Community Hours)**
- Core Team Leaders EDGE:** teens (Grade 10 & up) or adults who work together to help plan, implement, & run Edge Nights,. Responsibilities include running small groups, leading sessions and giving testimonies, engaging in youth relational ministry and outreach.
- Support Crew Members EDGE:** are teens and adults who assist in ways that align with one's schedule and gifts in such areas as event set up, hospitality, food ministry, signing in, art and design, photography etc. We would together establish your time commitment and the area you would like to help out. (5 hrs. per month)
- Hospitality Team:** Assist with preparing snacks and refreshments
- Adult Chaperones:** Supervise our youth on field trips, movie nights, outreach programs, and processions.
- Volunteer for Special Events:** Assisting with fundraising events, Christmas and Passion Plays, retreats etc. Assisting wherever needed.



I am involved/interested in the following **Parish Ministries**:

- ◇ **Altar Servers** - The server assists the presider, prepares the altar, makes sure that what is needed for the celebration is brought, carried or moved into place.
  - Children serve at the weekend Masses
  - Adults serve at the weekday Masses, Funerals, Wedding etc.
- ◇ **Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion** - An Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion is a layperson formally instituted to distribute Holy Communion during Mass. After proper instruction, many parishioners serve as Eucharistic Ministers at daily and weekend Masses.
- ◇ **Eucharistic Homebound Ministry** - our Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are called in a special way to minister to those of our community who are sick or are homebound, either due to illness or old age, and cannot attend Mass. In addition, they minister to the faithful who are in nursing homes.
- ◇ **Lector** - This ministry helps to facilitate the public prayer of the Church in the Liturgy of the Word. Lectors strive to make the Liturgy of the Word as meaningful as possible for the worshipping assembly, celebrated in a way that fosters meditation. After proper instruction, the Lectors proclaim the Word of God for our daily and weekend liturgies.
- ◇ **Music Ministry** - The Music Ministry of strives to lead and inspire our parish family to praise God with our instruments and voices at weekend liturgies and other parish services through-out the year. There is a children's choir, Adult/Family Choir and Violin Lessons for children.
- ◇ **Usher** - The usher greet you, help you find a seat, count attendance, pass the collection baskets, distribute the bulletin, offer assistance, and ensure an orderly process during the Sacrament of the Eucharist.
- ◇ **Finance Council** - The diocese provides policies and procedures to which all parish and mission financial councils must adhere. This group handles the finances of our parish.
- ◇ **Our Lady of the Visitation** - A group of individuals that bring the Eucharist to Humber Heights and Scarlett Heights Nursing Homes.
- ◇ **Ladies Auxiliary** - While sharing faith and fellowship, their hands and minds create beautiful and useful articles for sale. The proceeds are used for supplies and to offer donations to the church and other organizations.
